- Whereas,* during the first three years of a child's life, as well as the prenatal period, the brain is most actively developing, forming the basis for all future learning, behavior, and health; and
- Whereas,* decades of research show that babies and toddlers thrive when they have loving, responsive interactions in their earliest years and that a stable, secure relationship with a nurturing, caring adult is a key factor in their general development; and
- Whereas,* this delicate time in a child's life is often a challenging time for their parents, a time they feel unprepared and are most in need of a support system that will help them to gain the skills and resources they need to be a good parent and to create an environment that will help set their child up for success; and
- Whereas,* home visiting can include a variety of different programs and models, including prenatal, early childhood, and parenting education programs, during which practitioners help parents meet the unique needs of their children, promote healthy development, strengthen family relationships, reduce the risk of abuse and neglect, and promote equity by providing resources to families who are most vulnerable; and
- Whereas,* by providing services in the homes of the families they serve, home visiting practitioners offer families the opportunity to access support and information in a place they feel comfortable and at ease and in ways that respect their unique beliefs, traditions, and customs; and
- Whereas,* Brighter Beginnings, developed by the Boone County Community Services Department and the Cradle to Career Alliance in 2018 with funds provided by the Pritzker Children's Initiative PN-3 Grant, is a collaborative of home visiting, social service, and healthcare providers that seek to expand and simplify access to support for pregnant families and families with young children aged 0-5 in Boone County; and
- Whereas,* The Columbia/Boone County Department of Public Health and Human Services now oversees the Brighter Beginnings program which, through coordination across sectors and programs, works to strengthen protective factors and promote equity in early childhood outcomes; and
- Whereas,* National Home Visiting Awareness Week, April 20-24, 2026, celebrates and recognizes the vital work of home visiting practitioners like those at Brighter Beginnings and their contributions to the Columbia and Boone County Community through their commitment to supporting improved maternal-child health outcomes through child development screenings, preventive
