Scope of Proposal: Two full day presentations of the "A Victim's Plea; a 9-1-1 Call for Excellence" training on November 5th and 6th, 2026. The presentation will be hosted by **Boone County Joint Communications** and presented at Boone County Sheriff's Department Regional Training Center at 2013 E County Drive, Columbia, MO 65202.

Pricing: The **Denise Amber Lee Foundation** will charge **Boone County Joint Communications** a flat rate of \$6,500 per day of the "A Victim's Plea; a 9-1-1 Call for Excellence" training. Prices include all travel expenses, rental car, speaker fees for presenter.

About Us: The **Denise Amber Lee Foundation** is a nonprofit, 501(c)3, corporation. The foundation was borne out of the tragic kidnapping, rape, and murder of Denise Lee in North Port, Florida in 2008. Despite 5 calls made to 9-1-1 that day, including a 9-minute call from a bystander witnessing her abduction in the car next to her, Denise was not rescued before her murder. Denise's husband Nathan had made it his life's work to honor his courageous wife by promoting better training, standardized protocols, and technological advances for 9-1-1 so that it meets expectations of all citizens. Determined not to have Denise die in vain, Nathan is partnering with the 9-1-1 industry and using the powerful emotional ammunition of these tragic events to drive change in public policy. It is hoped that the public awareness and disgust of these tragedies, if channeled and focused in a responsible way, will lead to legislative changes in funding, training, certification, and technology.

Vision Statement: To be the emotional driving force for changes in the 9-1-1 system in order to minimize human error.

PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT
TRAINING: "A VICTIM'S PLEA; A 9-1-1 CALL FOR EXCELLENCE"
Denise Amber Lee Foundation

THIS AGREEMENT, Boone County Contract #C001152 , dated the 9 day of July, 2026 is made between Boone County, Missouri, a political subdivision of the State of Missouri through the Boone County Commission, on behalf of Boone County Joint Communications, herein "**BCJC**", and the **Denise Amber Lee Foundation**, herein "vendor", a tax-exempt, not organized for profit organization or governmental entity.

WHEREAS, the Denise Amber Lee Foundation has submitted a proposal detailing the services and training to be provided along with the expected cost to Boone County Joint Communications thereof; and

WHEREAS, Boone County Joint Communications has approved the proposal in whole or in part as hereinafter set forth.

IN CONSIDERATION of the parties' performance of the respective obligations contained herein, the parties agree as follows:

1. **Contract Documents.** This agreement shall consist of this agreement, C001152, and the Denise Amber Lee Foundation Proposal. All such documents shall constitute the contract documents, which are attached hereto and incorporated herein for reference. In the event of conflict between any of the foregoing documents, the terms, conditions, provisions, and requirements contained in this Agreement shall prevail and control over the Denise Amber Lee Foundation Proposal.
2. **Purchase.** BCJC agrees to purchase from the vendor, and vendor agrees to furnish **Two (2) sessions** in the month of November 2026, of the **"A Victim's Plea; a 9-1-1 Call for Excellence"** training for the Boone County Joint Communications Department, as described and in compliance with the vendor's proposal. The total allowable compensation under this agreement shall not exceed **\$13,000.00** unless compensation for specifically identified additional services is authorized and approved by BCJC in writing in advance of rendition of such services for which additional compensation is requested.
3. **Pricing.** Each training session shall be invoices at a flat, firm, rate of **\$6,500.00**. This rate includes travel expenses, transportation, and fees for the presenter as stated in Vendor's proposal.

4. **Contract Duration.** This agreement shall commence on the date of contract execution and extend through December 31, 2026, subject to the provisions for termination specified below.
5. **Billing and Payment.** The County agrees to pay all monthly invoices within 30 days of receipt of a correct and valid invoice and upon approval of any report due. In the event of a billing dispute, BCJC reserves the right to withhold payment on the disputed amount; in the event the billing dispute is resolved in favor of the vendor, BCJC agrees to pay interest at a rate of 9% per annum on disputed amounts withheld commencing from the last date that payment was due.
6. **Availability of Funds.** Payments under this contract are dependent upon the availability of funds or as otherwise determined by BCJC. This contract can be terminated if funding becomes unavailable in whole or in part for cause shown, and BCJC shall have no obligation to continue payment.
7. **Accreditation/Licensure/Certifications.** The Vendor must comply with all state/federal certification and licensing requirements and all applicable federal, state, and local laws and must remain in "good standing" with the applicable oversight entity.
8. **Failure to Perform/Default.** In the event that the Vendor, at any time, fails or refuses to perform according to the terms of this contract, as determined by BCJC, such failure or refusal shall constitute a default hereunder, and BCJC will be relieved of any further obligation to make payments to the Vendor as set out herein. This contract will be terminated at the option of the BCJC.
9. **Termination.** This Contract may be terminated, with or without cause, by either party upon thirty (30) days written notice to the other party. In addition, this agreement may be terminated by BCJC upon 15 days' advance written notice for any of the following reasons or under any of the following circumstances:
 - a. BCJC may terminate this agreement due to material breach of any term or condition of this agreement, or
 - b. BCJC may terminate this agreement if key personnel providing services are changed such that in the opinion of BCJC delivery of services are or will be delayed or impaired, or if services are otherwise not in conformity with proposal specification, or if services are deficient in quality in the sole judgment of BCJC, or
 - c. BCJC may terminate this agreement should the Vendor fail substantially to perform in accordance with its terms through no fault of the party initiating the termination, or
 - d. If appropriations are not made available and budgeted for any calendar year to fund this agreement.

Upon receipt of notice of termination, the Vendor shall make every effort to reduce or cancel outstanding commitments and shall incur no additional expenses. BCJC shall reimburse the Vendor for outstanding expenses incurred up to the date of termination, including un-

cancellable obligations and reasonable termination costs, but in no event, will such costs exceed the total funds presently allocated to this Contract.

10. Boone County Insurance Requirements: The Vendor shall not commence work under this contract until they have obtained all insurance required under this paragraph and such insurance has been approved by the County. All policies shall be in amounts, form, and companies satisfactory to the County which must carry an A-6 or better rating as listed in the A.M. Best or equivalent rating guide.

Compensation Insurance: Vendor shall take out and maintain during the life of this contract, Employee's Liability and Worker's Compensation Insurance for all their employees employed at the site of work.

Worker's Compensation: Worker's Compensation coverage shall meet Missouri statutory limits. Employers' Liability limits shall be \$500,000.00 for each employee, \$500,000.00 for each accident, and a \$500,000.00 policy limit.

Comprehensive General Liability Insurance: Vendor shall take out and maintain during the life of this contract, such comprehensive general liability insurance as shall protect them from claims for damages for personal injury including accidental death, as well as from claims for property damages, which may arise from operations under this contract, whether such operations be by themselves or by anyone directly or indirectly employed by them. The amounts of insurance shall be not less than \$1,000,000.00 per limit for any one occurrence covering both bodily injury and property damage, including accidental death. If providing Comprehensive General Liability Insurance, then the Proof of Coverage of Insurance shall also be included. Proof of Coverage of Insurance - Vendor shall furnish the County with Certificate(s) of Insurance which name the County of Boone – Missouri as additional insured in an amount as required in this contract and requiring a thirty (30) day mandatory written cancellation notice. In addition, such insurance shall be on an occurrence basis and shall remain in effect until such time as the County has made final acceptance of the project.

Vendor shall provide the County with proof of General Liability and Property Damage Insurance with the County as additional insured, which shall protect the County against any and all claims which might arise as a result of the operations of Vendor in fulfilling the terms of this contract during the life of the Contract. The minimum limit of such insurance will be \$1,000,000.00 per occurrence, combined single limits. Limits can be satisfied by using a combination of primary and excess coverages. Should any work be subcontracted, these limits will also apply. Coverage wording shall include hold harmless agreement as written below, subrogation waiver and protection against third party suits to further protect Boone County from liability belonging to the Vendor.

Professional Liability Insurance: The Vendor is required to carry Professional Liability Insurance with a limit of no less than \$1,000,000.00 and name Boone County as additional insured.

Commercial Automobile Liability: The Vendor shall maintain during the life of this contract, automobile liability insurance in the amount of not less than \$1,000,000.00 combined single limit for any one occurrence, covering both bodily injury, including accidental death, and

property damage, to protect themselves from any and all claims arising from the use of the Vendor's own automobiles, teams and trucks; hired automobiles, teams and trucks; and both on and off the site of work.

Proof of Carriage of Insurance – The Vendor shall furnish the County with Certificate(s) of Insurance which name the County as additional insured in an amount as required in this contract. The Certificate of Insurance shall provide that there will be no cancellation, non-renewal or reduction of coverage without 30 days prior written notice to the County. In addition, such insurance shall be on an occurrence basis and shall remain in effect until such time as the County has made final acceptance of the services provided.

Nothing in these requirements shall be construed as a waiver of any governmental immunity of the County, its officials nor any of its employees in the course of their official duties.

Failure to maintain the required insurance in force may be cause for contract termination. In the event the Agency/Service fails to maintain and keep in force the required insurance or to obtain coverage from its subcontractors, the County shall have the right to cancel and terminate the contract without notice.

11. Indemnification. To the extent permitted under Missouri law, Vendor agrees to hold harmless, defend and indemnify BCJC, the County, its directors, agents, and employees from and against all claims arising by reason of any act or failure to act, negligent or otherwise, of the Vendor (meaning anyone, including but not limited to consultants having a contract with the Vendor or subcontractor for part of the services), or anyone directly or indirectly employed by the Vendor, or of anyone for whose acts the Vendor may be liable in connection with providing these services. This provision does not, however, require Contractor to indemnify, hold harmless, or defend the County of Boone from its negligence.

Nothing in these requirements shall be construed as a waiver of any governmental immunity of the County, its officials nor any of its employees in the course of their official duties. Nothing in the insurance procured as required herein shall be interpreted so as to waive any sovereign immunity, official immunity, or other immunity defense available to County as a political subdivision in the State of Missouri. It is not the County's intent or desire to procure insurance that would operate as a waiver of any such immunity defense.

12. Binding Effect. This agreement shall be binding upon the parties hereto and their successors and assigns for so long as this agreement remains in full force and effect.

13. Entire Agreement. This agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties and supersedes any prior negotiations, written or verbal, and other proposal or contractual agreement. This agreement may only be amended by a signed writing executed with the same formality as this agreement.

Denise's husband Nathan had made it his life's work to honor his courageous wife by promoting better training, standardized protocols, and technological advances for 9-1-1 so that it meets expectations of all citizens. Determined not to have Denise die in vain, Nathan is partnering with the 9-1-1 industry and using the powerful emotional ammunition of these tragic events to drive change in public policy. It is hoped that the public awareness and disgust of these tragedies, if channeled and focused in a responsible way, will lead to legislative changes in funding, training, certification, and technology.

Vision Statement: To be the emotional driving force for changes in the 9-1-1 system in order to minimize human error.

K-9 MAINTENANCE TRAINING AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT dated the 26 day of MAY, 2026, is entered into by and between Boone County, Missouri (County), by and through the Boone County Sheriff's Office (BCSO), and Clinton County Sheriff's Office (Agency):

WHEREAS, BCSO can provide K-9 maintenance training through its certified K-9 training staff; and

WHEREAS, Agency desires to send its K-9 and handler through the BCSO's K-9 maintenance training program; and

WHEREAS, County and Agency have the authority to cooperate with each other for the purposes of this Agreement pursuant to RSMo §70.220;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is agreed by and between the parties as follows:

1. MAINTENANCE TRAINING. BCSO agrees to provide Agency's K-9 handler and K-9 maintenance training by and through BCSO's certified staff. Training areas will include obedience, narcotics detection, tracking, building search, area search, article search, K-9 aggression control, and scenario-based training. The training shall consist of not less than twenty (20) sessions. Agency will receive a certificate documenting successful completion of the BCSO's program.

2. EMPLOYED STATUS OF K-9 HANDLER. Agency agrees that the training contemplated herein is within the scope and course of its handler's employment and Agency will be responsible for all appropriate compensation and the provision of Worker's Compensation coverage to Agency's employee. Agency's handler will execute a Waiver & Release as set out in the attached Exhibit "A" prior to being permitted to participate in the training.

3. CONTRACT PRICE AND PAYMENT. Agency shall pay County a total sum of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00) for the training contemplated herein, calculated at a rate of \$100/session. Agency shall pay one-half, or \$1,000.00, upon execution of this contract and the remaining one-half, or \$1,000.00, after ten (10) sessions have been completed.

4. TERM AND TERMINATION. The term of this Agreement shall begin on the 1st day of June, 2026, for a period of one-year and may be renewed for two (2) additional, one-year contracts on the same terms and conditions as set forth herein. Either party may terminate this Agreement at any time by providing the other written notice of their intent to terminate at least 90 days in advance of the intended termination date. In the event of a termination, the parties will reconcile the payments paid and/or due based on the number of sessions attended and the rate of \$100.00 per session.

5. MODIFICATION AND WAIVER. No modification or waiver of any provision of this Agreement nor consent to any departure therefrom, shall in any event be effective, unless the same shall be in writing and signed by County and Agency and then such modification, waiver or consent shall be effective only in the specific instance and for the specific purpose for which mutually agreed.

6. FUTURE COOPERATION. The parties agree to fully cooperate with each other to give full force and effect to the terms and intent of this Agreement.

7. ENTIRE AGREEMENT. The parties state that this document contains the entire agreement between the parties, and there are no other oral, written, express or implied promises, agreements, representations or inducements not specified herein.

8. AUTHORITY. The signatories to this Agreement warrant and certify that they have obtained the necessary authority, by resolution or otherwise, to execute this Agreement on behalf of the named party for whom they are signing.

INFORMED CONSENT WAIVER AND RELEASE

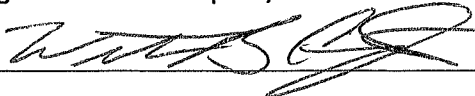

This release and waiver extends to all claims of every kind of nature, whatsoever, foreseen or unforeseen, known or unknown.

INDEMNIFICATION AND HOLD HARMLESS: I also agree to indemnify and hold harmless the Boone County Sheriff's Office, Boone County, Missouri, and/or its employees and agents all from any and all claims, actions, suits, procedures, costs, expenses, damages, and liabilities, including attorney's fees, that result from my participation in or involvement with the Program.

Now on this day the County Commission of the County of Boone does hereby amend Commission Order 261-2026 and impose a county-wide sales tax pursuant to the provisions of RSMo §67.582, in the amount of **three-eighths of one percent** for the period beginning the second calendar quarter after notification of the results of the special election referenced herein to the Missouri Department of Revenue **and expiring on December 31, 2042**. Said sales tax shall be for the purpose of providing law enforcement services within Boone County. Said sales tax shall be imposed on all sales which are subject to taxation under the provisions of RSMo §§144.010 – 144.527 as amended and, pursuant to RSMo §144.032, said sales tax shall also be imposed on all sales of metered water services, electricity, electrical current, and natural, artificial, or propane gas, wood, coal, or home heating oil for domestic use only. The tax authorized by this Order shall be in addition to all other sales taxes currently authorized.

The imposition of this tax shall be effective only after approval of a majority of the qualified voters casting a ballot at a county special election. It is further ordered that the County Commission of the County of Boone hereby calls for an election to be held on Tuesday the **3rd day of November, 2026**, for the purpose of submitting to the voters the proposition contained in the following Notice of Election and Sample Ballot:
