The Agreement **C000867 (sole source # 178-123125SS)**, dated the 3rd day of December 2024, made by and between Boone County, Missouri and **Corsair Controls, Inc.** for and in consideration of the performance of the respective obligations of the parties set forth herein, is amended as follows:

1. **Renew the contract for the period November 1, 2026 through October 31, 2027.**
2. **ADD** time and material pricing.
3. **Material Pricing:** Material supplied by the Contractor shall be at Contractor cost plus **20%**. Freight shall be at the Contractors cost and shall not be subject to markup. **Percentage shall remain FIXED for the life of the contract.**
4. **Prevailing Wage Order #33 is in effect for the period November 1, 2026 through October 31, 2027.**

Prevailing Wage is no longer required for public works projects valued at \$75,000.00 or less. (RSMo Sec. 290.230.5)

- a. If the bid accepted by the County for a "major repair" or "construction" of a public work project is \$75,000 or less, then the Prevailing Wage Law will NOT apply to the contract.
- b. If the bid accepted by the County for a "major repair" or "construction" of a public work project is greater than \$75,000, then the Prevailing Wage Law WILL apply to the entire project.
- c. Special Rule for Change Orders: If the County accepts a bid for less than \$75,000 for a "major repair" or "construction" of a public work and that contract is later subject to a change order that raises the total contract price over \$75,000, then the vendor is responsible for identifying that portion of the work causing charges that are in excess of \$75,000 and the Prevailing Wage Law WILL apply to only that portion of the project that is in excess of \$75,000.

5. Non-Prevailing Wage Labor Pricing:

Hourly Rate: \$130

For a reactive service, hourly rate is \$195

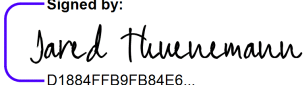
6. **Quote:** Before non-emergency repairs are approved, Contractor shall provide the County with a written quotation, detailing parts, and labor charges within three (3) business days. Quotations shall be based on the prices stated within this amendment. Emergency repairs may be quoted verbally to expedite the job, but a written quotation of the same detailing parts and labor charges shall follow within three (3) business

days. No work resulting in additional charges to the County over the original approved written quote shall be authorized without prior written approval from the County's Department Representative requesting the services.

7. Except as specifically amended hereunder, all other terms, conditions, and provisions of the original agreement shall remain in full force and effect.

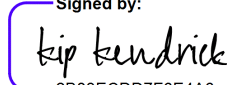

RE: Recommendation for Stop Sign Installation
Mill Creek Terrace at Old Mill Creek Road

Commissioners,

In preparation for our preservation chip seal project this year we discovered there is no stop sign on Mill Creek Terrace at Old Mill Creek Road. Currently, it is a "T" intersection and uncontrolled. The posted speed limits are 40 mph on Old Mill Creek Road and 30 mph on Mill Creek Terrace. Old Mill Creek Road is the major road as shown on the attached Exhibit 'A'.

I recommend installation of a "Stop" sign (R1-1) on Mill Creek Terrace at Old Mill Creek Road to establish minor road stop control.
