● Introduction to Emergency Preparedness

Discuss positive outcomes of preparedness, differentiate between hazards, emergencies & disasters, and identify hazards in our community.

● *Build a Kit*

Discuss the need to have an emergency kit, identify what to put in a kit, and encourage to build one at home.

● *Make a Plan*

Discuss the importance of having a communication plan, identify the different parts of a plan, and practice it with your household.
